

**GOD or LORD** in all CAPS has YHVH as the underlying Hebrew. This is the Father's revealed Name and it has been stolen from you. TAKE IT BACK!

**LORD = YHVH**

**GOD = YHVH**

**Lord = The Hebrew word, Adonai (which means my Lord, my Sovereign or my Master)**

**God = The Hebrew word, Elohim (which means Almighty or Mighty One)**

**When you see...**

**Say...**

The LORD ..... Yehovah (we do not need a "the" before a proper name.)

Lord (lord) ..... M(m)aster, S(s)overeign or L(l)ord depending on whether it's referring to a man or deity.)

GOD ..... Yehovah

God ..... Almighty or Mighty One (whichever best fits the sentence.)

Lord GOD ..... SovereignYehovah

LORD God ..... Yehovah Almighty

Jesus ..... Yehoshua, Yahushua, Yeshua (means "Yehovah will Save".)

Christ ..... This is the name of a Greek pagan deity (Cristos). The man from Galilee was never called by this title in his lifetime.

**Final Note:** the pronunciation suggested above is just that, a suggestion. As more light is revealed, a better pronunciation may be ascertained. Don't be too dogmatic with people who have accepted that YHVH is the Father's Name but have come to a different conclusion than presented here. Recognizing that He has a Name is the first step!

In the New Testament, when Lord or God is used, we need to understand that the faith of Israel was based on monotheism, they only had ONE deity, so all these terms should be understood to refer to the Father. If in context, these terms are found to be related to the man from Galilee, this idea was added after 325 A.D. after the Council of Nicaea. Until that time, "Jesus" was not considered divine. He was made divine by the edict of Rome at the Council of Nicaea. He became their "sun" god or Son of God.
