Should the righteous observe birth dates?

There is a reason why not a single birth date of a patriarch or prophet is found in Scripture. There is also a reason why the only birthdays celebrated in Scripture were by pagans and non-believers.

- **1. Genesis 40:20**, Pharaoh (who worshipped everything that moved, and some things that did not move) is revealed observing his birthday.
- **2.** Matthew 14:6, Herod (an Edomite sitting on the throne in Israel) observed his birthday, the drunken debauchery which resulted in John losing his head.
- **3. Job 1:4-5, 1:18**, Job's children all got together and celebrated each one's "day" in their respective homes, and ultimately they were all killed at the celebration in the home of their eldest brother.

Here is the reason only birthdays of pagans or non-believers are recorded in Scripture:

"THE highest of all holidays in the Satanic religion is the date of one's own birth. This is in direct contradiction to the holy of holy days of other religions, which deify a particular god who has been created in an anthropomorphic form of their own image, thereby showing that the ego is not really buried.

The Satanist feels: "Why not really be honest and if you are going to create a god in your image, why not create that god as yourself." Every man is a god if he chooses to recognize himself as one. So, the Satanist celebrates his own birthday as the most important holiday of the year. After all, aren't you happier about the fact that you were born than you are about the birth of someone you have never even met? Or for that matter, aside from religious holidays, why pay higher tribute to the birthday of a president or to a date in history than we do to the day we were brought into this greatest of all worlds?

Despite the fact that some of us may not have been wanted, or at least were not particularly planned, we're glad, even if no one else is, that we're here! You should give yourself a pat on the back, buy yourself whatever you want, treat yourself like the king (or god) that you are, and generally celebrate your birthday with as much pomp and ceremony as possible.

After one's own birthday, the two major Satanic holidays are Walpurgisnacht [May 1, or May Pole Day] and Halloween (or All Hallows' Eve)." *Anton LaVey, The Satanic Bible, p. 96, 1976 edition.*

The day of one's birth is the highest of all the satanic holidays. Naturally. And in complete contradiction **Ecclesiastes 7:1** says: A good name is better than precious ointment; and the day of death [is better] than the day of one's birth.

If the day of our death is better than the day of our birth, and the origin of birthday observation is pagan or worse, satanic, and the Most High instructs us to learn NOT the way of the heathen, is there any reason to question or debate the celebration of one's birth any further? We have a *Thus saith YHVH*...

Thus saith YHVH, Learn not the way of the heathen, and be not dismayed at the signs of heaven; for the heathen are dismayed at them.

For the customs of the people are vain... Jeremiah 10:2-3

Celebrating our own birthday is just as pagan as celebrating New Years, Valentines, Easter, May Pole Day, Halloween, Thanksgiving and Christmas. As a believer, you have been called *OUT of her my people*, remember? If you think that observing just a few of these pagan celebrations or even just ONE of them is a safe option, might I inquire WHY this is so?

Actually, I already know why you might wish to retain some of these pagan observations...

"A long habit of not thinking a thing wrong gives it the superficial appearance of being right." *Thomas Paine*.

"Most of our so-called reasoning consists in finding arguments for going on believing as we already do." *James Harvey Robinson*.

"There is a principle which is a bar against all information, which is proof against all arguments, and which cannot fail to keep a man in everlasting ignorance; that principle is contempt prior to investigation." *Herbert Spencer*

The object is to make sure you and I can stand before the Judgment of YHVH with a clear conscience. With all due respect, the truth has not been suspended just for you. Almighty Yah does not care about your tradition or what you *think* is true; He wants you to follow HIM. The way to do this is by proving all things and holding fast only that which is good. We learn what is good by searching the Scriptures daily to see whether these things (that we've been taught) are true. (I Thessalonians 5:21, Acts 17:10-11)
